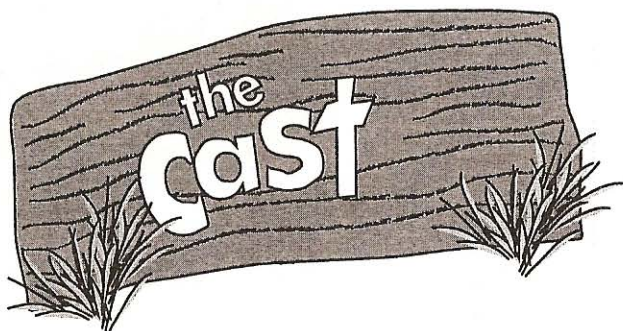


- No flash photography during the performance

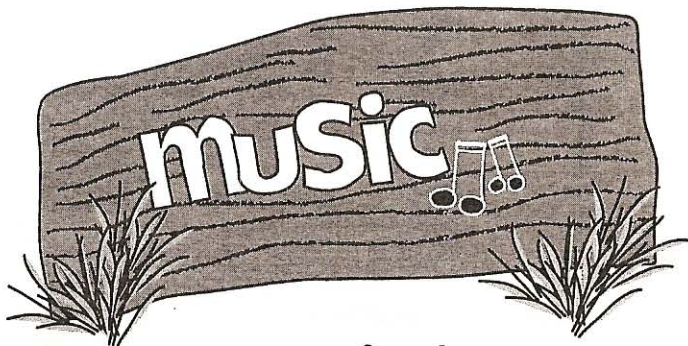
